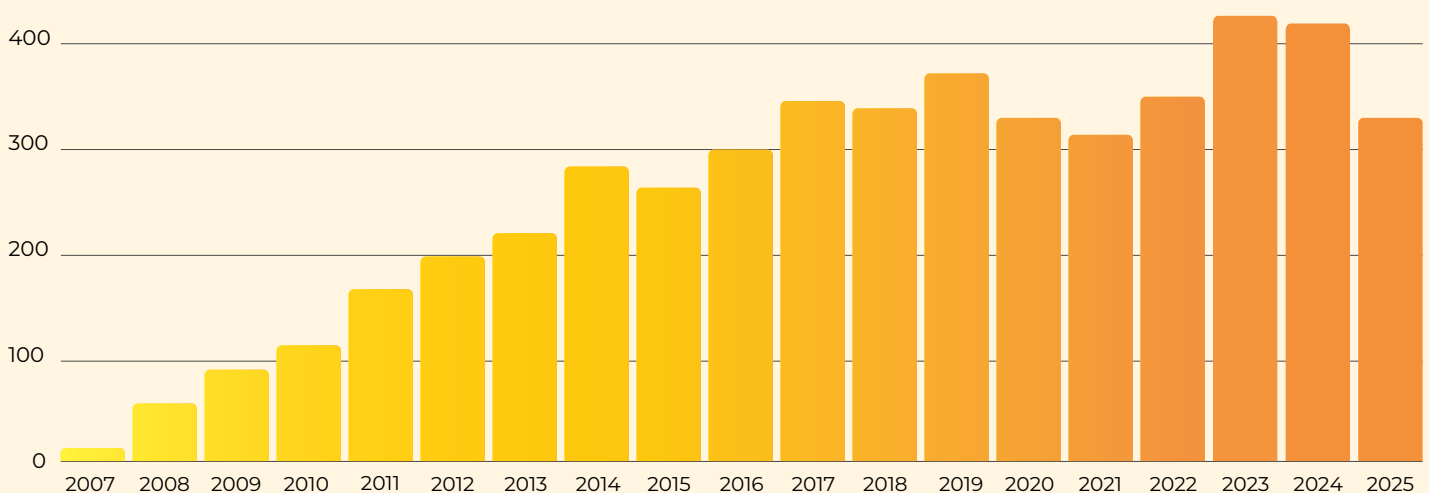

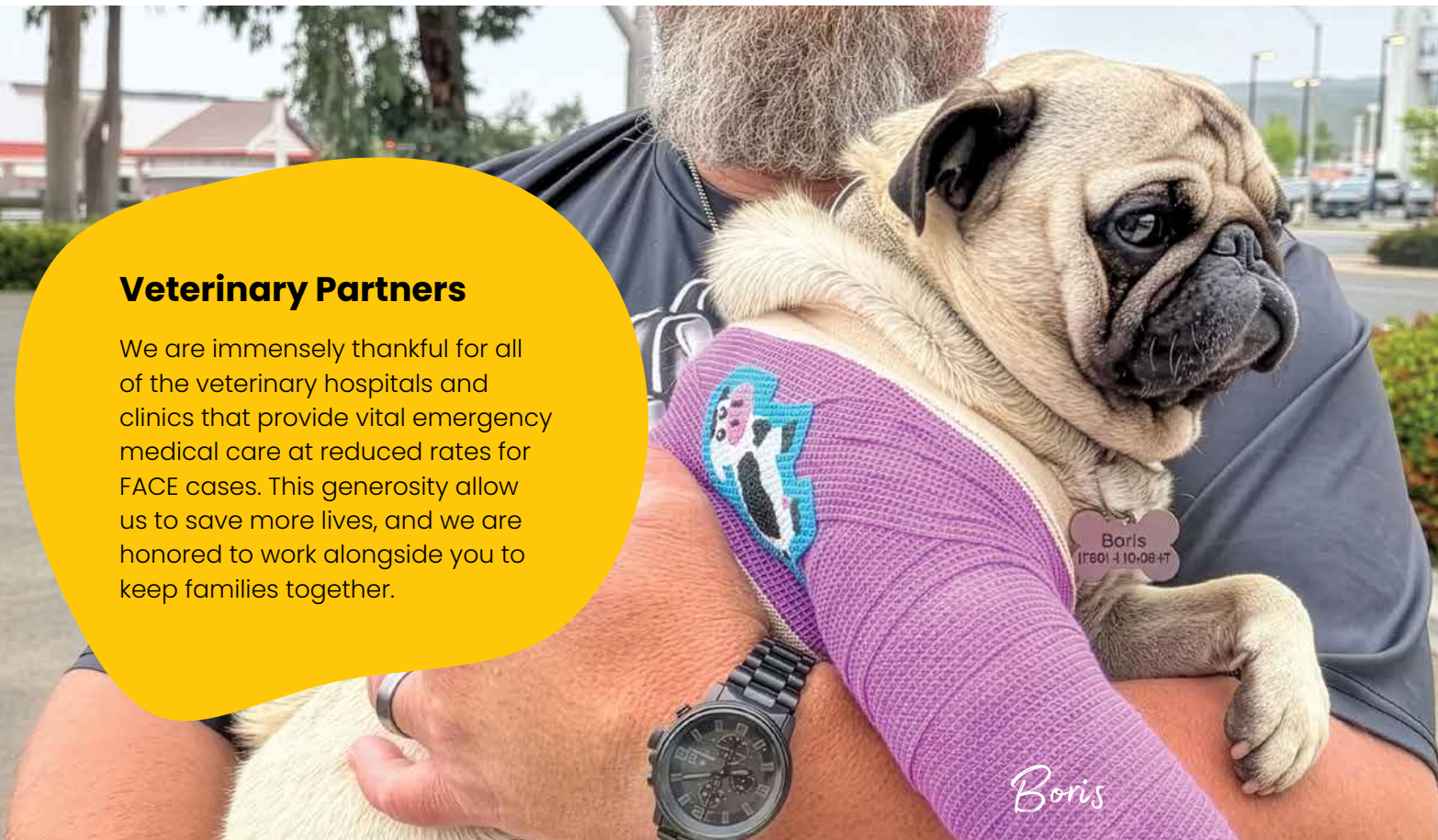

Since 2015, our Community Outreach and Engagement efforts have reached thousands of pet families across San Diego, working side by side with more than 15 dedicated social service organizations. In 2025, we participated in 12 events in areas with a high concentration of unhoused individuals and families.

Joining the SD City C.A.R.E. Program, Think Dignity, the Burrito Boyz, and many others, we continue this vital work—having served nearly 600 unhoused individuals in 2025 alone. By working alongside other dedicated organizations—including NAMI, Veterans Village, and Alpha Project—we've strengthened referral pathways to help more pet owners.

Whether we are providing essential supplies or fostering face-to-face connections, our mission remains the same: ensuring that financial hardship never breaks the invaluable bond between a person and their pet.

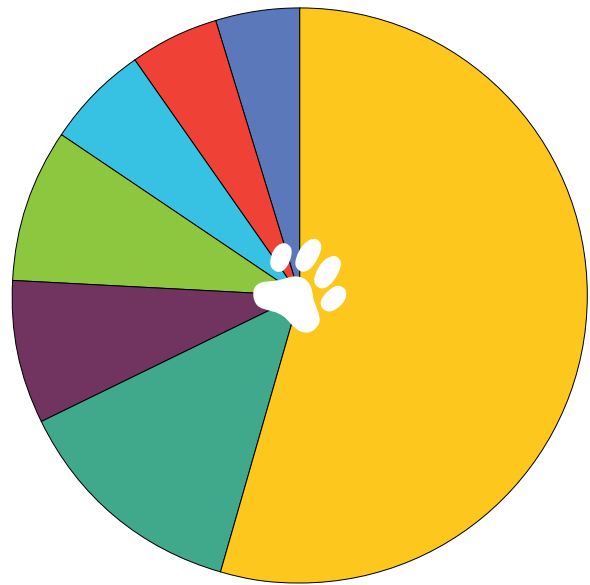
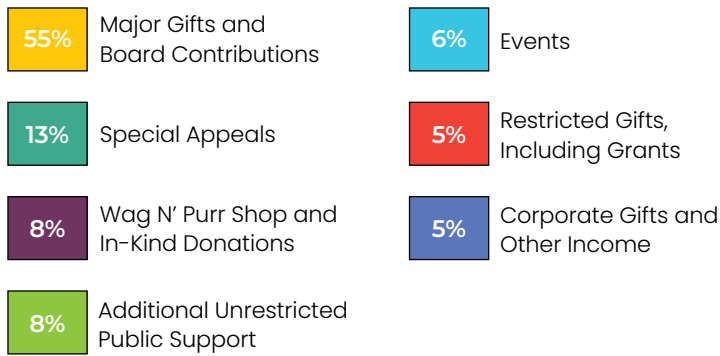
FACE is blessed with a wonderful community of donors, and with our Board of Directors contributing in many meaningful ways, we closed the year with a healthy net income figure – priming the foundation for a successful 2026.

Retrospectively, FACE’s program expenses amount to about 75% of total expenses, with fundraising, management and general expenses around 25%. 2025 was a unique year and we will have audited figures later this year. So far, we anticipate the following:

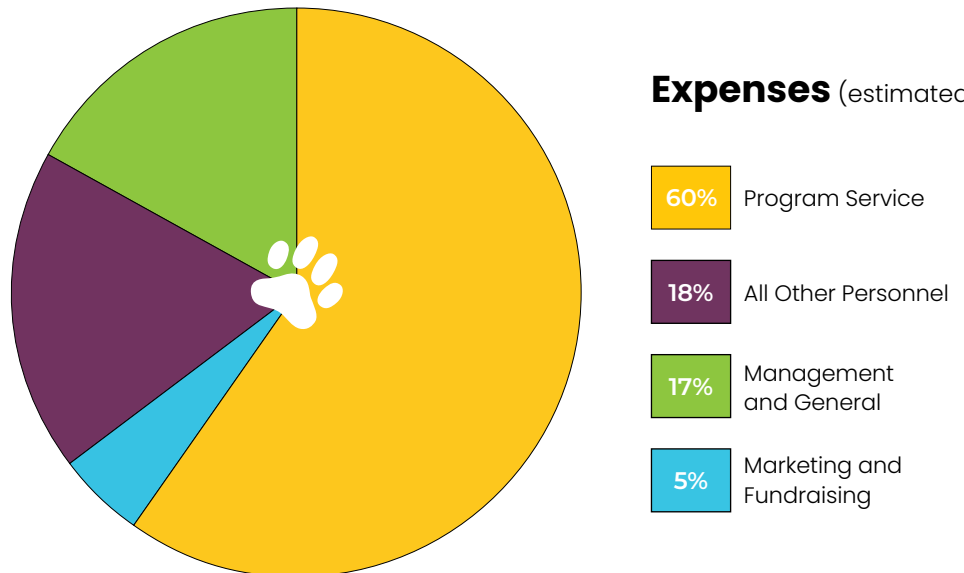

For families confronted with the impossible choice of losing a treatable pet because they cannot afford emergency or specialty veterinary care, FACE has been there to offer hope, help, and a second chance.

To honor this achievement, FACE is preparing to launch a special campaign: \$100 for each of the 5,000 lives saved. 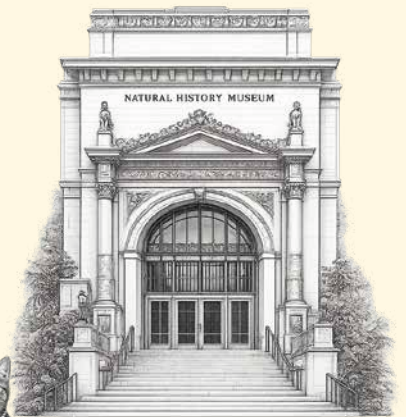

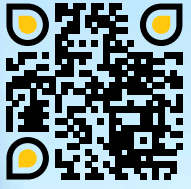
