REUNITING FAMILIES A LETTER FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



When we visit an animal in a veterinary hospital's recovery room right after a FACE-funded, life-saving surgery, or we visit their family in a waiting room, that is where all the hard work, the long hours, the overnight case management, the grueling and often tough decision that comes with the job melts away. I can't really explain that instantaneous feeling and it's hard not to get sentimental putting it on paper. FACE touches the lives of San Diegans in such a unique and powerful way. As we review 2022, our memory is flooded with images of Blueberry, Juanita, Boe, Spunky, Shadow, Maple, Milo, Bronny...and so many more lives FACE has SAVED. The generosity of our supporters is the key to being able to name these animals, making personal and positive changes in the lives of our community. As we review 2022, we are nothing short of overwhelmed with gratitude.

After moving to the Executive Director (ED) role after being on the Board of Directors, I have fallen even more in love with the Foundation in which I have been a fan of since its inception. I have served on the Advisory Committee, on the Board of Directors and in the ED role. I have seen every angle, every factor in the equation that makes this organization tick. The staff is small but so, so mighty. The Board of Directors is populated by a group of incredible animal advocates in which their intellect and skill sets are only surpassed by their passion for animals. FACE Foundation's Advisory Committee and faithful volunteers spend thousands of hours selflessly contributing to the mission. I was an advocate for the mission before the job, I remain completely smitten with FACE as the new ED.

A significant and notable change in 2022 was the growth and metamorphosis of FACE's Community Outreach Program. While funding life-saving veterinary care and eliminating economic euthanasia will always be our primary mission, we have experienced and observed an increase and desperate need in San Diego for pet owners experiencing homelessness and food insecurity. This means that hunger, shelter, and the basic needs have become more of an issue for pets and pet owners. I could write a book on why these folks end up in their situation and what their pet means to them; every scenario so drastically different than the other but that's for another time. This program has grown swiftly, new collaborations are being born and strengthened, coalitions with friends of other non-profit organizations are being formed. We are expanding our ability to assist in new ways and continuing our promise to "Save Pets and help families."

In conclusion, to every single person that donated time, treasure, or talent to our organization in 2022; YOU carried us through a very tough time. YOU have allowed us to save lives when many of the country ceased operations during a historical pandemic. There is nothing I can say that would be a sufficient proclamation of gratitude. For many, animals became the only companion during a time of unprecedent isolation. Your donations not only impacted pets, but during the last couple of years, you kept them with their humans when they never needed them more.





COMMUNITY OUTREACH

Our outreach program continues to grow rapidly as more and more people are facing financial hardship and are in need of assistance. In 2022, FACE collaborated with 6 different organizations to provide a total of 24 outreach events, supplying 4,423 bags of supplies and resources to those facing financial hardship and/or experiencing homelessness.






